Dear Steve:

In September of 2009, we purchased the Enviro-Save product for three of our service trucks and since that time we have installed the product in all of our equipment. This includes large equipment such as a backhoe, frontend loader, dump trucks and street sweepers down to our lawn mowers.

In all applications, the Enviro-Save product has performed exceptionally well and in some cases exceeded expectations. A case in point would be when during our heaviest snow of the season we had a hydraulic hose burst on one of the dump trucks we use to push snow and spread salt. The operator didn't realize it until the hydraulics quit working. He then drove it back to the shop and the hydraulic pump was so hot you could smell it. After letting it cool overnight, we repaired the hose, refilled the hydraulic system and the pump has worked perfectly ever since. This represented a \$2,000.00 savings. A couple of weeks later we had the same thing happen to a different truck with the same results. Another \$2,000.00 saved in the cost of the pump alone. This does not include labor. The Enviro-Save hydraulic treatment without question saved those pumps and being a one-time treatment we did not have to add any more Enviro-Save to the hydraulic fluid.

Another instance was the front seal of an Allison transmission on our tanker truck was leaking. Repairing a front seal is time consuming and expensive. We installed the Enviro-Save automatic transmission treatment and the leak has stopped.

To date, we have installed the Enviro-Save product not only here at the Department of Public Works, but also in our Town Hall vehicles, Wastewater Department, Water Department, Police Department and the Town's emergency generators.

We are pleased with our decision to purchase Enviro-Save as we have experienced no mechanical failures in any application where the product has been installed.
