Hi Dave,

I wanted to give you an update after receiving the Enviro-Save kit for my car. I installed everything about 10,000 miles ago. Essentially soon after receipt.

When I was in California I knew the gas mileage would be within one or two mpg every time I filled up. It seemed no matter where we went everything averaged out over the 250 miles I averaged between fill ups. So I thought it would be the same here. Not so.

More freeways and more stop and go. Then for the summer heat, started in early May, there are many instances where I sit for 20 minutes waiting to go in for an appointment with the air conditioning going full blast in the car, but not moving. No help on the mpg area.

Even with doing those strange things and now having 130,000 miles on the Infiniti, I just filled up today and I'm still averaging about 22 mpg. That is better than California by slightly less than 10%, but I think if I were driving California style the percentage would be much greater.

We took a trip to Florida for a total of over 2000 miles and averaged 27.5 mpg with highway speeds of hardly ever less than 72 and normally 77 mph (65 and 70 mph speed limits). The high mileage was 29 mpg on one tank, and that was at the 77 mph speed for about four hours.

I'm impressed. If Enviro-Save can make a difference on a car with 120,000 miles when the Enviro-Save kit was installed, then it has to be great!
